FIL FEST USA 2022 SALUTING OUR MILITARY AND A CELEBRATION OF FILIPINO-AMERICAN CULTURE

October 8 & 9 at Mt. Trashmore Park *Honoring Joint Service Military Heroes*

(Virginia Beach, Va.) – In its eighth year, Fil Fest returns to Mt. Trashmore, recognizing Filipino-American History Month. This year's theme: A Salute to the Military.

The two day free family-friendly community event scheduled for October 8 & 9 opens up with a Zumbathon and then kicked off with Mayor Dyer's message and recognizing five military Next Geners from the Navy, Air Force and the Army. The most recent State Historical Highway marker in Virginia Beach commemorating Filipinos who have served in the US Navy and the recent approval of the naming of a Navy Destroyer, Telesforo Trinidad marking the first ever ship named after a Filipino gives headway to history in the making and noteworthy to celebrate.

These historical events reflect the rich history and culture of the Navy and the Filipino Community, celebrating two institutions that have had a great impact to the Hampton Roads. This honor will recognize the service of all who have served and currently serve and to inspire next generations of all military service branches.
